

Fourth Annual George Strait Country Music

Country Music Headliners and Brightest Stars Come Together For One of the Largest and Most Successful Tours in the Industry


Nashville, Tenn. (November 10, 2000)

Country music icon George Strait plays host once again to some of the finest talent in the industry. The Fourth Annual George Strait Country Music Festival, which kicks off March 2001, will continue the tradition of its platinum-selling and award-winning line-up. Artists to-date include superstar Alan Jackson, multi-platinum group Lonestar, chart-topping traditionalist Lee Ann Womack, this year's CMA"Horizon award-winner Brad Paisley and Grammy award-winners Asleep at the Wheel. Additional performers for the all-day festival will be announced at a later date. The exact tour dates and cities are not finalized but will be announced in January along with ticket on-sale dates.

Nominated for "Tour of the Year" and "Most Creative Tour of the Year" by Pollstar three years running, The George Strait Country Music Festival has been of the highest-grossing tours in the industry alongside such stellar acts as Bruce Springsteen, N'Sync, Elton John, Dave Matthews Band and The Rolling Stones. It is the only music tour of any kind that plays stadium dates annually. Since its inception, the tour has grossed over 90 million dollars in ticket sales alone, played to over 2 million people with just under 45 stadium dates and averaged an audience of 45,000 people per show.

Bruce Hinton, Chairman of MCARecords remarked, "George Strait is an icon in our business and his festival stadium shows have become the annual event for country music. The fans know they are guaranteed fabulous music, a quality experience when it's a George Strait event."

It's the quality of the show and the exposure it garners that makes artist managers and book-

ing agents compete to have their clients invited to join the elite line-up.

And it is the type of exposure that has made artists such as the Dixie Chicks and Kenny Chesney credit the tour as being one of the key elements of their career strategy.

"The George Strait Tour was part of our tour strategy in 1999," said Emily Robison of the Dixie Chicks. "We wanted to build our fan base before launching our own tour and by performing in stadiums packed with country music lovers, we did just that. The enthusiasm from that many people was staggering - it made for a really fun show."

"Being on these tours is priceless," says Kenny Chesney, who was on the Strait bill for the last two years. "You can't put a dollar amount on it. The relationships you make with the people there, the things that you learn from everybody are just unbelievable. There's something to be learned from people who have had careers like George Strait has."

Joe Galante, Chairman of RCALabel Group adds, "The fact that Kenny Chesney was on the last two George Strait tours was a big part of his album debuting at #1 on the country charts. The Festival's fans are active buyers. They remember when someone does a great job on stage and has great music, and at some point, they go buy it. Also, it's one of the best tours that I've ever seen in country music."

It's evident why acts wishing to take their careers to greater heights join the troupe but what makes artists who have headlined their own tours and who have "Entertainer of the Year" status choose to participate?

When asked about his participation on the upcoming tour, Alan Jackson replied, "I've always respected George Strait, his music, and career. I've been a fan of his for 20 years.

His music is one of the reasons I came to Nashville, so naturally I'm honored to tour with him next year. Besides, you got cowboy hats, screaming women, partying good ol' boys, and great country music - how could I say no?!"

What began 7 years ago in San Antonio, Texas at the Alamodome as a celebration honoring hometown hero and country music superstar - George Strait, is now a day-long festival that brings thousands of fans to the stadium for some of country music's hottest performers. That one-day music spectacular has become one of the most heavily attended events of the past three years outselling Lilith Fair and other notable mainstream music shows. And it's no wonder. Artists who have previously appeared on the festival stage have included Tim

McGraw, the Dixie Chicks, Faith Hill, Martina McBride, John Michael Montgomery, Clay Walker, Lee Ann Rimes, Jo Dee Messina, Kenny Chesney, Mark Chesnutt, Lee Ann Womack, Asleep at the Wheel, Clay Davidson, Lila McCann, Mark Wills and others.

"Fans consider the 10-hour event a bargain," says Louis Messina of SFX Music Group. "There is no other tour like it in country music. Or other genres for that matter."

Borrowing a carnival element from Lollapalooza, the festival devised Straitland, a midway offering games, a variety of food and drink, autograph booths, contests to win prizes including front row seats and backstage passes and a

second stage featuring country music up-andcomers. The family atmosphere of Straitland is always a hit for fans of all ages.

As for the host, George Strait has been named country music's top grossing touring artist of the past decade and has won and been nominated for countless "Entertainer of the Year" nods from both the Country Music Association and the Academy of Country Music. But it's fellow tour mate, Tim McGraw that says it best, "There's nothing like kicking back, drinking a beer and watching a master (Strait) on stage." For additional information on the George

New Changes In Fan Club

For many years fan club seating has only been available at one box office in each city, and for many years we have had questions as to why it could not be expanded and made available to everyone everywhere by phone and fax as well as in person. The answer has simply been that there is not enough manpower available to do it right. With our annual tour hitting bigger venues but fewer cities, many fans have to travel further and do not have the opportunity to benefit from fan club seating. Well, technology and the Internet has come to our rescue and changed all of that.

Effective with the beginning of the 2001 George Strait Country Music Festival Tour, Special Fan Club seating will now be available only through the Internet. This will give fan club members all over the country, and the world, the opportunity to purchase good seats for each tour stop. We will set

aside a specific number of seats and make them available to fan club members 48 hours in advance of each on-sale date. Each show will have a special fan club code that will be e-mailed to our fan club members in advance of the on-sale date. Members will then go to the George Strait Website and click on the Ticket Master link that will be handling the tickets. Remember that fan club seats are not, and never were designed to be the best seats in the venue and there is no guarantee as to the exact location of the tickets. They were only created in order to make sure that our fans were given the opportunity to purchase good seats before they were sold out. The very best seats may still be available to anyone who is willing to stand in line at the box offices or take their chances purchasing tickets through Ticket master on-line.

In order for members to take advantage of

the special fan club seating, we must have your email address on file. Please go to the website at www.georgestrait.com and click on the section in the middle of the home page that says "Information For Fan Club Members Only." Please complete the form and this will assure you that all necessary information is on file.

In the past, members have been allowed to purchase 2 tickets to each performance. This will be changed in 2001 to 4 tickets. It is imperative that we point out that fan club seating is only for the fan club members and anyone found abusing the privilege would be eliminated from our membership rolls.

We hope you like the changes. While no system is perfect, we are always working to do the best for our members and provide the most benefit to the most fans.
