

George Strait added a 5th major country nusic award to his list of accomplishments 'or the year at the 32nd Annual Country Vusic Association Awards show. Strait vicked up his third consecutive "Male Vocalist of the Year" award from the CMA luring the nationally televised show. Strait's 'irst two awards of the year came at the American Music Awards when he picked up rophies for "Best Country Male Artist" and "Best Country Album." He followed that with the "Male Vocalist of the Year" and "Album of the Year" awards from the Academy of Country Music.

In addition to his awards, Strait has now received more Country Music Association award nominations than anyone in history. His five nominations for 1998 gave him a total of 47, breaking the previous record held by Merle Haggard. Two other artists who will be performing with Strait during his 1999 George Strait Country Music Festival Tour also won awards. They included Tim McGraw who won the award for "Album of the Year" and the Dixie Chicks who won the "Horizon Award" for new artists and "Vocal Group of the Year." The tour begins in March.



Planning Is Underway For George Strait's 1999 Tour

The 1998 George Strait Country Music Festival Tour was the biggest in country nusic history as almost one million fans experienced the excitement generated by the events in only 18 tour days that lasted from he middle of March through the middle of une. The festivals included George Strait ind six other acts in day long events that ook place in football and baseball stadiums round the country. It also included a unique trea outside the stadiums named 'Straitland," where fans could spend time before the events and during set changes. 'Straitland" featured a separate stage for /oung upcoming talent as well as food and beverage outlets, concession stands and

sponsor booths. In many locations there were carnival rides and mid-way games. It was the most unique and special tour ever attempted in country music, and it was a huge success.

The 1998 tour included Tim McGraw, John Michael Montgomery, Faith Hill, Lee Ann Womack, Lila McCann and Asleep at the Wheel. It took two huge sound and light systems, two extremely large stages and hundreds of people to make the shows work. It was also so enjoyable for the entertainers that George Strait has decided to do it again.

The 1999 George Strait Country Music Festival is tentatively scheduled to begin the first weekend in March and end the first weekend in June. The routing for the tour has not been completed as negotiations are still being held with stadiums across the country. While the routing will not be completed for several weeks, it is believed that festival shows will be held in most sections of the country including the northeast.

The line-up for the 1999 tour has not been completed but it is known that Tim McGraw and the Dixie Chicks will be included. We will have a complete line-up and a complete list of all of the tour dates in the next issue of Strait Talk. We will also have all the information on the Official George Strait Website at www.georgestraitfans.com when it becomes available.






